BOARD EXAM RESULTS 2024-2025

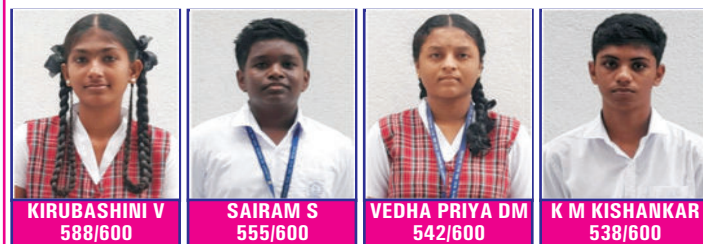

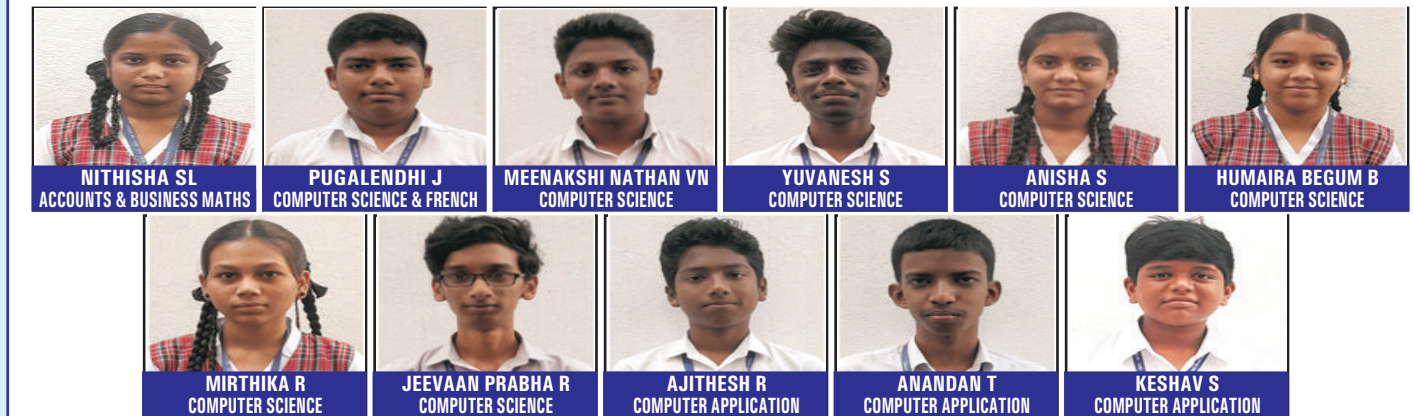

And are a source of prosperity.

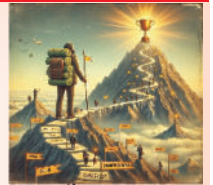

Difficult times come in life, but we must not give up. A student may find a subject hard, but studying a little every day helps. A player may lose a match, but practice makes them perfect.



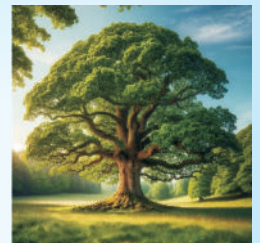

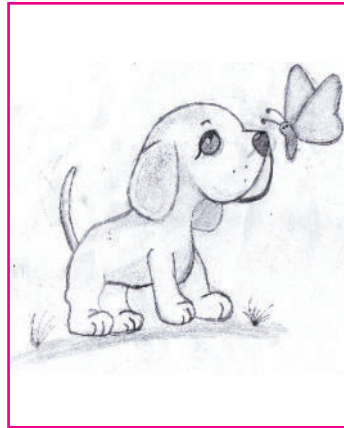

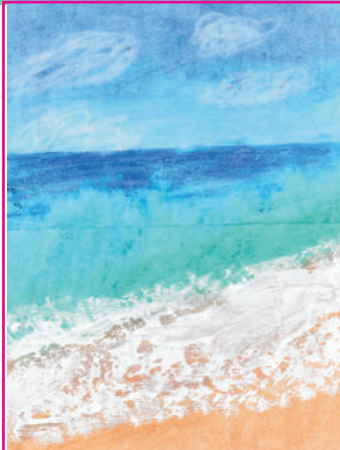
